

BRIDGEPARK MANOR CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) POLICY

DATE: November 10, 2020 - Effective November 12, 2020

Today the Government of Manitoba has declared that the entire province will be moving to a Critical Red Zone Thursday, November 12th. The following measures have now been put into place at Bridgepark Manor and will be effective Thursday morning, November 12th.

Visitors:

- **NO VISITORS**
- **2 designated family caregivers will be able to enter the building to see you. Please speak with your family and notify the front desk of which family members will be designated.**
- Designated family caregivers are asked to **wear masks in the building** at Bridgepark Manor upon entry and **throughout their time in your units** at Bridgepark Manor.
- All designated family caregivers must complete an active screening test at door #330, masks and physical distancing are expected throughout your time together.
- All essential service providers and delivery personnel must report to the front desk at 330 Stone Bridge Crossing.
- Health Care Professionals must report directly to the front desk (entrance #330) to complete an active screening test. Upon successful completion of Bridgepark Manor's active screening test they may proceed into the building wearing a mask throughout the building.

Staff:

- **All staff members will wear a mask when in the public areas of Bridgepark Manor. This includes all departments.**

Residents:

- The Dining Room is closed and your meals will be brought to your units beginning November 5th.
- All activities have been suspended until further notice.
- The use of all the public areas will be discouraged for the next 4 weeks, this includes the lobbies, multipurpose rooms, libraries, and exercise/games rooms.

You may still check your mail and walk in the hallways with a mask on. Please distance yourself from others at all times.

- Please limit your trips outside of the building to essential appointments. Your designated family caregivers may bring you essential items or leave them with the front desk to be picked up.
- If you do not have family to shop for you and need Bridgepark Manor to shop for your essential groceries, please contact the front desk.
- Please monitor yourself for symptoms daily. If you have any symptoms please call health links and advise the front desk of your situation.
- Please also remember to use a mask when leaving your unit and wash your hands with warm soapy water often.
- Multi-Purpose Rooms and guest rooms will continue to not be rented out until further notice.

A reminder:

- If you leave Bridgepark Manor, physical distancing should be adhered to. We suggest that you wear a mask when in a car with people other than your own household and anytime you are in a situation where you are exposed to the public. Please stay vigilant and do not relax your efforts to stay safe.
- If you have flu like symptoms such as a fever, headache, sore throat, coughing, and runny nose remain in your unit and **call HEALTH LINKS at 204-788-8200** or call your family to have this checked out. **Please also report this to Bridgepark Manor administration immediately and avoid people until you are feeling better.**
- **If a resident has had contact with someone who is ill with Covid like symptoms we ask that administration is notified as soon as possible. This is to ensure the proper precautionary steps are taken to keep our building safe.**



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
